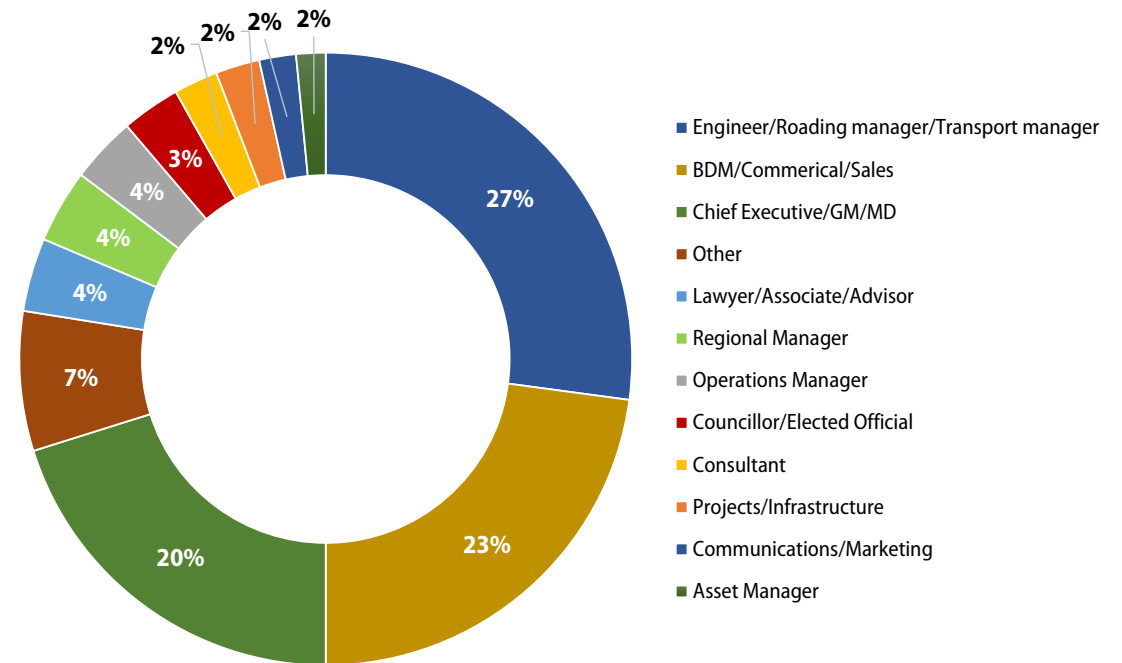

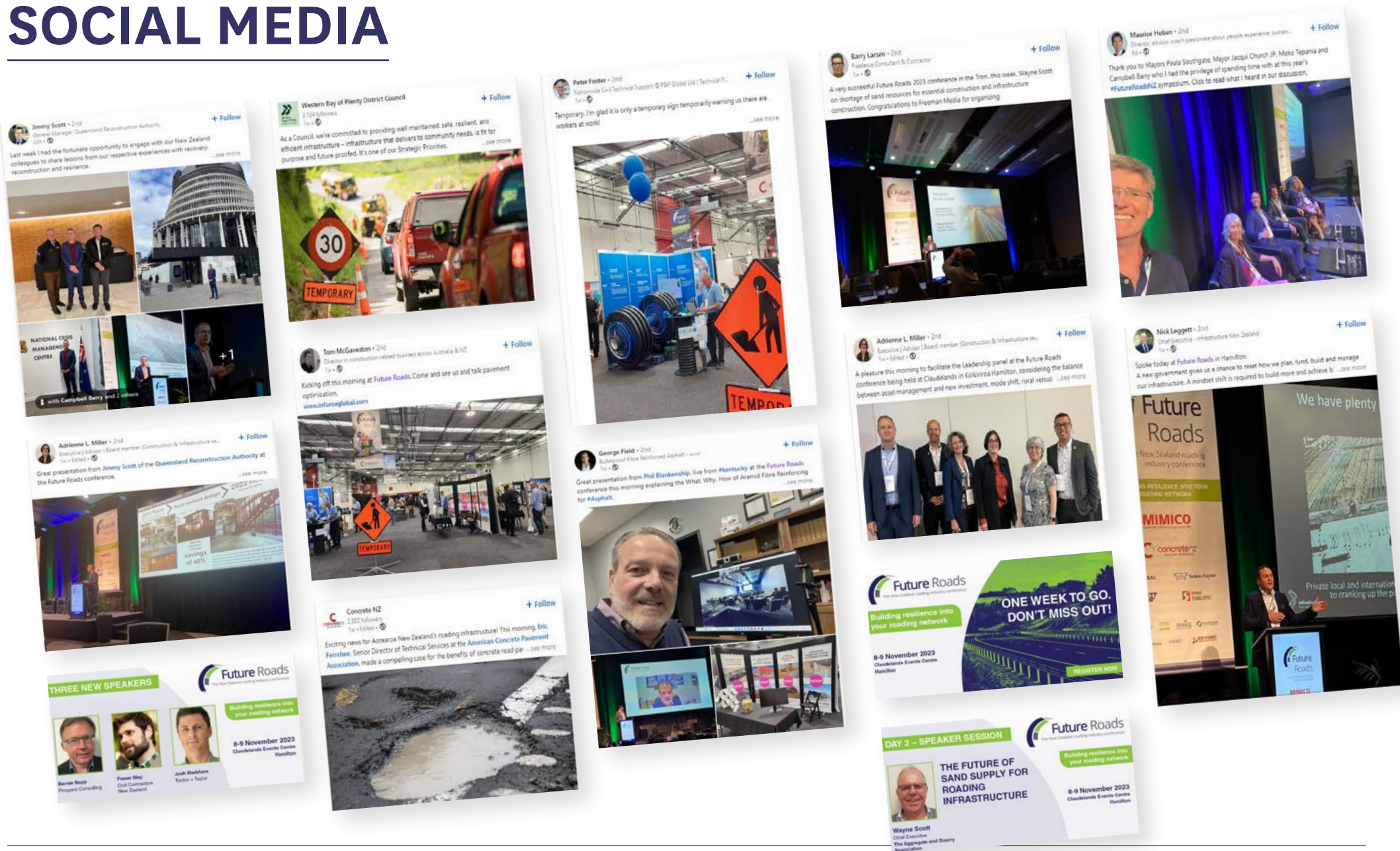


NET PROMOTER SCORE
